
Weekly Profile Report for the Canning Estuary and Lower Canning River

21st April 2020

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Canning River Estuary - Physical-Chemical Profile - 21st Apr 2020



Date: 21st April 2020

Weather & tide conditions: Conditions were clear with a predominantly northerly breeze of up to 6 knots. The predicted tides at Barrack St were 0.77 m at 4:33 am (low tide), 0.96 m at 11:14 am (high tide) and 0.83 m at 5:28 pm (second low tide) and flow was observed at Kent St Weir. Gosnells recorded 5 mm of rainfall during the week prior to sampling (Bureau of Meteorology).

Oxygenation: The Nicholson Rd and Bacon St oxygenation plants were both triggered to provide oxygen in the 24 hours prior to sampling.

Canning Estuary (downstream of Kent St Weir): The Canning Estuary was saline between SCB2 and RIV and brackish over saline at CASMID. Surface waters were oxygenated or well oxygenated and bottom waters were low in oxygen at RIV and anoxic at CASMID. Chlorophyll fluorescence was low throughout this zone. Water temperature ranged from 20.1 to 22.6 °C.

Lower Canning River (upstream of Kent St Weir): The Lower Canning River was fresh and waters were oxygenated or well oxygenated. Chlorophyll fluorescence was low to moderate in this zone. Water temperature ranged from 18.5 to 20.1 °C.

Oxygenation Plant Operational Status:

- ▲ Operating for part or all of the 24 hours prior to sampling
- ▲ Operable but not triggered to operate in the 24 hours prior to sampling
- ▲ Inoperable for part or all of the 24 hours prior to sampling

Definitions:

Salinity – fresh <5, brackish 5-25, saline 25-35, hypersaline >35
Dissolved oxygen – well oxygenated >6mg/L, oxygenated >4-6mg/L, low oxygen >2-4mg/L, hypoxic 0.5-2mg/L, anoxic <0.5mg/L
