
### Canning Estuary and Lower Canning River

8<sup>th</sup> September 2020

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## Canning Estuary and Lower Canning River- Water Quality Profiles- 8<sup>th</sup> September 2020



Date: 8<sup>th</sup> September 2020

Weather & tide conditions: Conditions were cloudy with a variable breeze of up to 4 knots. The predicted tides at Barrack St were 0.93 m at 1:53 am (high tide), 0.72 m at 10:45 pm (low tide) and 0.72 m at 12:13 pm. Gosnells recorded 33.5 mm of rainfall during the week prior to sampling (Bureau of Meteorology).

Oxygenation: The Bacon St and Nicholson Rd oxygenation plants were operational but not triggered to provide oxygen in the 24 hours prior to sampling.

Canning Estuary (downstream of Kent St Weir): The Canning Estuary was brackish over saline at SCB2, fresh over brackish at SAL and fresh from RIV to CASMID. Waters were oxygenated or well oxygenated and chlorophyll fluorescence was low throughout this zone. Water temperature ranged from 15.8 to 18.3 °C.

Lower Canning River (upstream of Kent St Weir): The Lower Canning River was fresh and waters were well oxygenated throughout this zone. Chlorophyll fluorescence was highest at PAC indicating higher microalgal activity in this area. Water temperature ranged from 15.4 to 15.8 °C.

**Oxygenation Plant Operational Status:**

- ▲ Operating for part or all of the 24 hours prior to sampling
- ▲ Operable but not triggered to operate in the 24 hours prior to sampling
- ▲ Inoperable for part or all of the 24 hours prior to sampling

**Definitions:**

Salinity – fresh <5, brackish 5-25, saline 25-35, hypersaline >35  
Dissolved oxygen – well oxygenated >6mg/L, oxygenated >4-6mg/L, low oxygen >2-4mg/L, hypoxic 0.5-2mg/L, anoxic <0.5mg/L
